Convict's History from History Services Database

- 1839 Upon arrival noted as husband of Patrick Bean, who arrived in the William Jardine in 1838 (6)
- 1840 Absconded from S. Wallace, Sydney, since 23/3/1840 (1)
- 1844 Ticket of Leave, Sydney, 14/5/1844 (4)
- 1844 Ticket of Leave altered to Sydney so long as in service of the Government as a Turnkey at the Gaol, 17/5/1844 (4)
- 1844 Ticket of Leave altered to Newcastle, 17/9/1844 (4)
- 1845 Surrendered her Ticket of Leave for Newcastle as her husband deserted her & she was returned to the Female Factory (ordered by Hyde Park Barracks, Bench) 5/6/1845 (5)
- 1845 Absconded from John Wearin, Sydney, since 31/8/1845 (2)
- 1845 Apprehended on 3/9/1845 after abscondment from John Wearin, Sydney (3)
