Convict's History from History Services Database

- 1830 Upon arrival in Colony assigned to Cornelius Prout, Sydney (1)
- 1833 Received 50 lashes during September 1833 inflicted by the Sydney Police Bench for grossly neglecting his duty. He cried loudly at the second lash & repeated cries at every lash. At the twelfth lash the blood was flowing largely & he seemed to suffer intense agony. It was believed he was sufficiently punished at the twenty fifth lash. He stated he was flogged the previous Saturday but the marks on his back were very slight (7)
- 1837 With C. Prout, Liverpool, aged 23 (8)
- 1837 Absconded from M. Casey, Nelson Plains, since 12/2/1837 (2)
- 1840 Absconded from G. B. Christmas, Appin, since 12/4/1840 (3)
- 1840 Apprehended (4)
- 1845 Ticket of Leave, Moreton Bay, 26/3/1845 (5)
- 1850 Conditional Pardon notice (6)
