## **Convict's History from History Services Database**

- 1828 Upon arrival assigned to John Simpson
- 1828 Was a Tailor to John Simpson, Evan, aged 22 (2)
- 1830 Apprehended after abscondment from Archibald Bell, Esq, Belmont (5)
- 1832 Applied to marry Margaret Hughes alias Mary Whalan, per Forth 1830, Sydney, 2/8/1832. Application approved (6)
- 1835 Absconded from J. Reddall, Argyle, on pass, since 28/12/1835 (3). Apprehended (4)
- 1840 Ticket of Leave, Port Phillip, 25/3/1840. Cancelled for drunkeness & placed in Probationary Gang, 18/6/1840. Restored for Maitland, 21/1/1841(41/229). Cancelled & placed upon Pinchgut Island [Fort Dennison] for 1 year for highly disorderly conduct, Maitland Bench, 19/9/1842. Replaced for Queanbeyan, 22/1/1844 (1)
- 1845 Died in January 1845, Queanbeyan (7)
